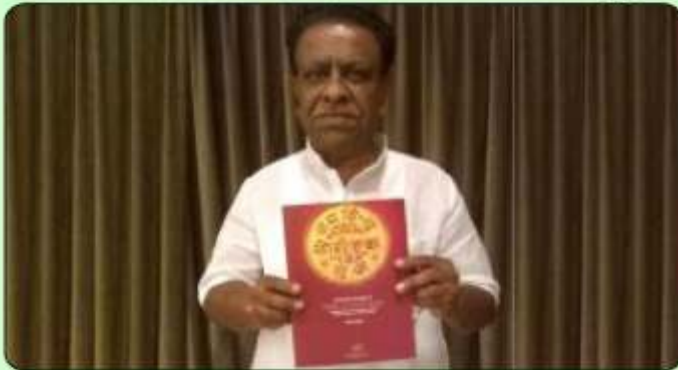

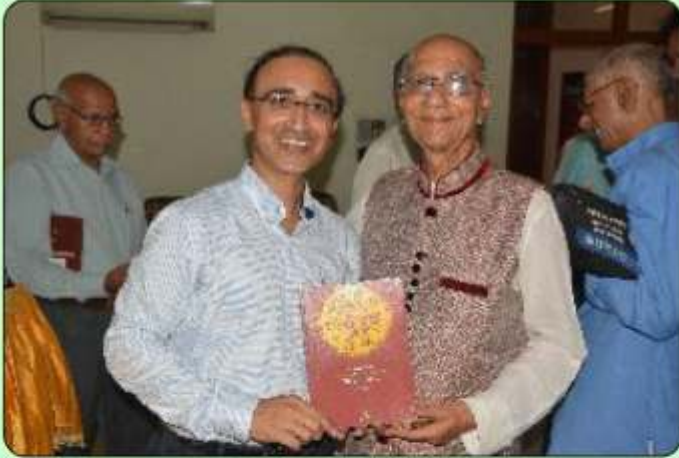

We have covered many Stories, Instances & Questionaries in the past News Letters.

We discussed the following important Questions,

- 1) Is the family involved while you are collecting coins?
- 2) Are there heirs who will want the collection from a collectors standpoint?
- 3) Where is the inventory of the collectibles kept?
- 4) What is the approximate value of coins?
- 5) How well the coin are preserved & kept?
- 6) Does any collectibles in your possession belong to someone else?
- 7) Are there certain dealers or other experts you trust or provide guidance to your heirs?
- 8) Is there a Auction house/Firm/Shop that you or your heirs will wish to use in the collections disposition after your death?
- 9) Has the Collection been Appraised or Insured? Does it need to be Updated?

In this News letter we will try to understand different ways of Selling the Collections. As there are Pros & Cons to each Method. This News letter will outline Specific methods for selling your Collection.

The General Rule for Selling is that " Time Is Money ". This means that, all other things being equal, the sooner you receive payments for your collections with less effort you put into Sale. Outright sale is without question the easiest method of selling a whole or partial collection. You present your collection to one or more buyers. They make offers. As the time you are investing in the process is limited. Either you Accept or Decline. If you Accept you receive Your payments & go on with your Life.


As we assume that you are offering a Collection of Substance to a Dealer who specializes in the field. Through references & Affiliations on can easily locate a qualified Dealer. Specialized Dealers are most likely willing to Buy an entire Collections.

A Dealer is looking and buying two different kind of Collections :

A : First, those items/coins/collectibles for which they know they have customers, or which are readily liquid in their retail. They are items/coins/collectibles on which they can afford to accept the lowest margins, because their carrying & marketing cost will be limited & risk for not finding a buyer will be minimal.

B : Second, are the items/coins/collectibles that do not fit this criteria. Items/coins/collectibles that are not routinely traded, bulky pieces where shipping & weight is also a factor and which will require greater effort to sell. Such items/coins/collectibles will be figured/estimated/bought cheaply as the expenses & effort to resell will be additional. Finally dealer has to survive with some profits.
